

Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

I understand and acknowledge that horse riding is a dangerous activity and that horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt. I understand and acknowledge that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from horse riding activities and in particular this lesson. I agree that I PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK.

I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this lesson. I understand that these terms and conditions apply every time I participate.

Safety Requirements

Correct safety gear must be worn –AS/NZS 3838 head gear or better, riding boots (**no joggers**); appropriate clothing (long pants and sun smart shirt) and sunscreen must be worn. No excessive jewellery or strappy tops, no shorts or three quarter pants.

LESSON / BOOKING CONDITIONS

- 🐾 Riders must arrive 10mins prior to commencement of lesson; lesson will start and finish at the scheduled time.
- 🐾 24 hour notice from the time the lesson is booked is required to cancel or postpone a lesson due to any circumstance (sickness, injury, and other commitments). Term, Block, Squad, Individual lessons & all other lessons will forfeit the prepaid lesson if less than 24 hours notice is given or pay a cancellation fee \$30 per 30mins, \$45 for 45mins & \$60 for 60min lesson. **Cancellation must be received before 5.30pm the previous day to be accepted. SMS is sent as a courtesy and does not override the 24hr notice.**
- 🐾 All lessons are valid for 12 months from date of purchase and are **Non-Refundable.**
- 🐾 **Cancelling repeated lessons in a block - more than two cancellations within a 4 week period can cause you to lose your time slot.**
- 🐾 Weather – due to safety reasons, lessons will be cancelled if rain conditions becomes too heavy or heat temperature exceeds 38°C. Please phone the centre to reschedule lesson.
- 🐾 Our Equipment are living (horses) and they do get sick or have days out of sorts. This means that their performance can vary or they have days off. This may result in the movement of horses, coaches and riders around to make the safest possible riding conditions.
- 🐾 All Coaches at WCEC are EA Certified or working towards their EA Certification. All Coaches participate in the Internal Training System.
